"SB 3321 will **protect children during interrogation** by requiring that they have a lawyer with them throughout the custodial interrogation. Juveniles aged 13 to 18 are at risk of prosecution in adult court. Depending on their statement, even being at or near the scene of an offense could trigger transfer provisions that send them automatically to adult court (and adult mandatory sentencing) based on accountability". - Juvenile Justice Initiative https://www.jjustice.org/

United States Election Assistance Commission: BE A POLL WORKER!

Students, including high school juniors and seniors who are citizens, can earn \$250 by being a poll worker. (So can other citizen adults.) **You can earn \$250** for a long day on election day in November, **plus \$50** for a few hours of training beforehand.

****If you are in high school, you will get an official excused absence on that day.**** And you will learn first-hand about how democracy works! Learn more at: <u>https://www.eac.gov/help-america-vote</u>

October 8 - Deadline for registration via mail or in-person

October 21 - Deadline for registration online

(If you will not be able to vote on November 5th, you can request a mail-in ballot or vote early.)

October 21 - First day to vote early.

October 31 - Deadline to request a mail-in ballot

November 5 - Mail-in ballots must be postmarked
